Subject: Appointment of the Late Baroness Tomlinson as new President

The Federation of European Equine Veterinary Associations (EEVA) has appointed its latest President. In its constituent year 2020 it elected the appointment of each of its Management Committees (and has re-elected their terms, as is usual). The Late Baroness Tomlinson was elected the President of the Association for the next three years.

The Baroness Tomlinson has been proposed for the position by the British Equine Veterinary Association (BEVA), British Horse Veterinary Association and President of the Board of the UK Veterinary Company, including National Vet, Veterinary Services, The Society for Veterinary Practice, a former member of BEVA (now a Chartered) Trust and states that she has been invited to undertake the role of President (2020) and will do so in accordance with the Association's (2020) Statutes. She has been the President of BEVA since 2018.
